- President overview
  - Continued operations with new Membership system
  - Staff shortages and concerns
  - Security and trespassing issues
  - Social response at all time high
  - Back to full operations at Pool & Tennis
  - New Pool Manager
  - Traffic study
    - Shiloh and Gartner: new flags installed, city study did not find that anything additional should be done
    - West and Williamsburg: city does not use stop signs to slow down traffic, suggests crossing at Emerald and West.
    - West and Gartner: Investigations are ongoing, median nose will be extended to protect pedestrians
    - Request will be made with the city for speaking at next council meeting to address our concerns

## Financials

- 2022 revenue was up from 2021 and over projected budget
- Expecting higher income in 2023 due to assessment increase, higher level of nonresident members at pool
- Salaries were higher in 2022
- o 2022 contribution to reserve was \$54k
- o Locker room and light fixtures were updated last year, projects came in under budget
- Pool pump was an unexpected cost
- This year, plan to review roof, pavement, sidewalks and concrete deck, update pump controller
- o Reserve balance at \$543k
- o 99.8% of dues collected in 2022
- Pool operations and grounds
  - New pool manager intro
  - Updated security at pool with cameras and motion sensors
  - Advanced purchase of supplies amid supply chain issues
  - Lifeguard hiring
  - o Trimming of trees around pool and common areas. Includes removal of dead trees

- Tennis and concessions
  - Looking for new tennis instructor
  - o Will communicate need with HOA Facebook group if current leads fall through
  - o If no instructor is found, tennis may not happen this year.
  - Looking at concession outsourcing options for more food choices and control of inventory
  - o Potential to allow members to add money to account in esoft for paperless checkout
- Communications and membership
  - Still using esoft as primary communications tool with members
  - Members need to ensure that the "Promotional Email" checkbox is marked so they can receive emails from the board. This is a legal requirement.
  - O Directory Spot is back up and running. Use this to meet and contact your neighbors.
  - Membership system is being updated to allow members to pay online for things like concessions, guest passes and lessons.
  - Non-resident members have been asked if they are returning, most are. Will backfill those non-returning slots with waitlist.
  - Waitlist currently stands at 93 non-resident families

  - O How is the money stored?
    - We are exploring higher interest options. Currently stored in two bank accounts to maintain FDIC insurance.
  - Planned professional fees are up this year
    - Reserve study is coming this year, added new security system that has a large one-time cost

- o Can we add solar lights to detect motion and deter break-ins?
  - Concern about shining lights into surrounding resident homes. Will explore after room assessment is completed
- o Plans to repair woman's shower?
  - Will be on the list for pool opening this season. Low usage.
